## EIKON The Mundaring Arts Centre Members' Christmas Exhibition

The Mundaring Arts Centre invites members to create and submit original artworks based on the theme, Eikon.

*Eikon: the Greek word meaning an image or likeness of any kind. In Eastern Orthodoxy and other icon-painting Christian traditions, the icon is generally a flat panel painting depicting a holy being or object but may also be cast in metal, carved in stone, embroidered on cloth, mosaic work, or printed on paper or metal. Anything that is representative of something else is an EIKON, nothing is implied about sanctity or veneration or its absence by the word itself.*

Artists could investigate icons, symbolic interpretations of the imagery prevalent at Christmas, different religions, faiths and ideology or yuletide themes i.e. peace, love, sharing, family and giving to those less fortunate.

As this is the Mundaring Arts Centre Member Christmas Exhibition we suggest artwork is **small and affordable**. The Mundaring Arts Centre Main Gallery will be the display space for the Exhibition. Artists may enter up to five artworks, but selection will be influenced by the amount of artwork received.

It is suggested that artwork is less than 1m x 1m to allow maximum member participation.

Next year is the Mundaring Arts Centre's 30th Anniversary and we intend to reproduce selected exhibition images as postage stamps in recognition of this milestone. Therefore a suggested size of 36cm x 46cm for 2D work is our preference. Pre stretched canvas in this size are available through MAC for purchase.

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

### ELIGIBILITY

Entrants must be current Mundaring Arts Centre Members.

### DEADLINES

- Submission forms due Monday 20 Oct 2008 with **\$10 non refundable admin fee**  
- Artworks due Wednesday 12 Nov 2008 (late entries may not be accepted)

### IDENTIFICATION

All work must be clearly identified on the back/base with the enclosed ID form. This details your name, address, telephone number, title of the work, size and medium. Please also include the price you wish to be paid for your work, we will add our commission onto this.

### SALES

All work submitted must be for sale. A commission of 35% will be deducted from all work sold. Please keep in mind that this is an Affordable Member Exhibition, with a suggested retail price of \$500 or below. If you wish to discuss pricing, please contact MAC.

### ORIGINALITY AND TOPIC

Artwork to be based on the theme of "Eikon" All artwork must be recent original work of the artist.

### PAYMENT

Payment for works sold will be forwarded to artists after the exhibition has closed.

## Please read carefully

### SUBMISSIONS

All two-dimensional artwork must be fitted with secure concealed hanging devices. Sale prices must include frames and commission.

### ACCEPTANCE

The Mundaring Arts Centre's selection committee will only be able to select a limited number of artworks, due to space limitations. When selecting, entries will be judged on their interpretation of concept and consideration of design elements including colour, shape, composition, clarity and quality of presentation.

### JUDGING AND SELECTION

The selection committee's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into. The People's Choice award will be chosen by the public and the winner announced at the end of the Exhibition.

### COPYRIGHT

The Mundaring Arts Centre will allow entries to be reproduced by newspaper, television and reproduced as postage stamps unless advised otherwise by the artist.

### COLLECTIONS

All unsold works must be collected between 17-21 January 2009. Agents collecting work must have the exhibitor's signed authorisation.
